Weekly Market Highlights

- It was another week of higher wheat futures prices, however Thursday's close and Friday's market are failing to follow suit.
- At this point market participants will need to consider whether futures over \$10.00 per bushel are truly warranted.
- Farmers seem to believe they are. At significantly lower prices even less wheat could show up for sale.
- Basis levels for high protein spring wheat have eased, but continued poor performance by rail companies could reverse that trend very quickly.
- Strong export sales, especially to countries facing political unrest in the face of food shortages, have caused the recent run-up in futures. Supply concerns will not be alleviated for some time. Expect continued volatility.
