

Alert: Harsh Weather is affecting National Supply Chain

Due to the harsh weather conditions across the United States, many of the commodity supplies have been affected.

The Mid-West and eastern half of the country have virtually no supply due to the frozen crops. This has resulted in increased demand pressure on our local supply to provide more products nationally as well as not receiving the extra crops from the affected areas. Transportation costs have also risen as a result to compound the issue.

In addition, California fields and crops out of the desert regions have been facing harsh conditions as temperatures are falling into the freezing range. This will result in Harvest loss as well. Leaf items out of Yuma have been affected by the loss from Sclerotinia. The local leaf item crops have been affected by freezing temperatures as well.
