


#### **Market Commentary**

Commentary: Last week all of the agricultural commodities had a significant bounce as the U.S. dollar slid in comparison to the Euro. The week improved for the European Union as Germany and France were in talks to help Greece with their debt issues. In my opinion this is a short-term solution and I believe near in the future that Greece's economic issues will become fore-front again. The soybean complex, specifically soybean oil saw solid demand too which added to its positive move. Also bean oil and meal are out of balance which is hurting the crush margins. The reality of the market is starting to question last week's USDA report and the soybean S& D balance sheet. The government is playing games, trying to sway the direction of the market and traders are becoming aware of this. Unfortunately this has been common lately where traders have little faith in the USDA reports. The current harvest is doing well and is about 60% complete, leaving late planted beans and corn left to be harvested. The harvest yields are not in yet, other than expected yields, so we have no real bushels per acre number at this time. We will soon.




#### **Corn - CBOT Weekly Futures Price**




## Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel
























#### **Barrel Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound**












#### **Live Cattle - Average Weekly Price USDA - 6 State Average**




