trending unchanged. The undertone is steady to mostly steady. Retail and food service demand continues light to moderate. Offerings and supplies are moderate to heavy. Market activity remains slow to moderate. Breaking stock prices, along with checks and undergrades, are lower. The undertone is barely steady to weak. Offerings are heavy on light demand. Supplies are moderate to heavy. Market activity is slow. North Central regional light type hen removal costs remain steady. Offerings are light to moderate for the moderate to good demand. Schedules are full-time. Market activity is moderate.

This compares to 159.5 million head the previous week and to 161.5 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 163.2 million head and the composite weighted average price was 86.80 cents per pound.






