Expected movement is for the period July 10-July 23, 2011. Prices are for Monday, July 11, 2011 compared with Tuesday, July 5, 2011. Unless otherwise stated, sales are F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis (including Delivered Sales, F.O.B. Shipping Point Basis) or port of entry and extra services are included. Prices represent open (spot) market sales by first handlers on product of generally good quality and condition unless otherwise stated and may include promotional allowances or other incentives. No consideration is given to after-sale adjustments unless otherwise stated. Brokerage fees paid by shipper are included in the price reported. The marketing season will be getting underway shortly for Lemons from Mexico, Nectarines from New Jersey and Washington as well as Washington Peaches.
