National Egg Review

This week, prices in New York are higher for the larger sizes, slightly lower for medium. Early in the week, regional prices were steady to higher for jumbo and extra-large, steady for the balance of sizes. Next week's regional asking prices are trending sharply higher for extra-large, higher for large,

and steady for medium. The undertone is fully steady to firm for jumbo and extra-large, steady to fully steady for large, and steady to weak for medium. Retail demand is mostly moderate. Food service demand is light to moderate. Offerings are light for jumbo and extra-large, light to moderate for large, and moderate to heavy for medium. Heat continues to affect production and egg size in many areas of the country. Market activity is moderate. Central states breaking stock prices, along with checks and undergrades, are higher. Demand ranges

light to fairly good, mostly moderate to fairly good. Offerings are light. Supplies are light to moderate. Market activity is moderate. North Central regional light type hen removal costs remain steady. Demand and offerings are light to moderate. Schedules range part-time to full-time. Market activity is slow to moderate.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 03-Sep-11 is estimated at 151.5 million head. This compares to 152.5 million head the previous week and to 163.5 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 167.8 million head and the composite weighted average price was 84.73 cents per pound.
