#### **National Egg Review**

This week, New York prices are steady on all sizes. Early in the week, regional prices were steady to higher for extra-large, and higher for large and medium. Next week's regional asking prices are trending unchanged. The undertone is steady to barely steady. Retail demand ranges light to good, mostly moderate. Food service demand is light to moderate. Offerings are moderate. Market activity is moderate to instances slow in the Southwestern region. Central states breaking stock prices are mixed with checks and

undergrades higher. The undertone is barely steady. Demand is moderate. Offerings are light to at times moderate. Supplies are light to moderate. Market activity is moderate. National light type hen removal costs remain steady. Demand is light to moderate while offerings are moderate. Processing schedules are mostly full-time. Market activity is slow to moderate.

# WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 01-Oct-11 is estimated at 149.5 million head. This compares to 150.7 million head the previous week and to 162.2 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 168.6 million head and the composite weighted average price was 83.14 cents per pound.
