


Market Commentary

Commentary: The soybean market was down last week while corn was higher. This does not bode well for the soybean complex as corn and beans fight over swing acres. Corn is winning as I have been reporting. Soybeans must keep up pace with corn or we will get to a point where there are fewer beans planted and the price will jump up then. It is a matter of timing, only beans may inflate further than necessary. There were mixed reports coming from South America as rains did hit much of their growing region, and this is why beans were down last week, for the most part. There was quite a bit of volatility all around, but the AG markets are still working within a range. Beans tried last week to get close to the bottom of the range. Wheat was another issue all together. Wheat moved into positive territory but not following corn. Russia announced they were rationing wheat sales and not going to export any more for the remainder of the year. This sent wheat higher. I believe it is simply a ploy to move their wheat price higher. Time will tell, but currently, they are not exporting.


Corn futures closed between \$6.31-3/4 and \$6/41-4/3 per bushel, ending the week at \$6.39. Soybean futures closed between \$11.85-1/4 and \$12.22-3/4 per bushel, ending the week at \$11.99. Soybean meal futures closed between \$312.70 and \$323.60 per short ton, ending the week at \$319.30. Soybean oil futures closed between \$0.5025 and \$0.5194 per pound, ending the week at \$0.5087. Wheat futures closed between \$6.41-1/4 and \$6.60 per bushel, ending the week at \$6.60.







Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel





Soybean Meal - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / US Ton


















Barrel Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound




40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound










Live Cattle - Average Weekly Price USDA - 6 State Average






Heating Oil - Average Weekly Spot Price - NY Harbour









Gasoline Unleaded - Average Weekly Highway Price





Natural Gas Futures - New York Mercantile Exchange












Foreign Exchange Rate - Euro, EMU Members
