


#### **Market Commentary**

Commentary: There was not a lot of progress last week regarding Greece's austerity measures and it played a part in adding volatility to markets. Over the weekend, though, an agreement was met, so this week, commodities will likely be higher as the Euro will get a bounce. This is causing rioting though, so we will see if that impacts any of the markets. Closer to home the USDA reported an uptick in Chinese exports from both the U.S. and Brazil, and there are cargoes reported to be sold in March also. South American production is still a concern, though it has improved, but many believe that the USDA estimate is too high for SA, and they will fall well short of their estimate. Early harvest information has production lower than expected and this will put a premium on U.S. beans, and will affect the acre war between beans and corn. The global situation for beans and the U.S. stocks is far below comfortable. Along with a weaker U.S. dollar, higher crude oil prices, and increased export demand, next week's futures will likely see a significant jump. I believe, futures may climb out of the range we have been locked in on the high side. Wheat prices were lower last week in spite of lower USDA numbers globally.


Corn futures closed between 6.31-3/4 and 6.44-1/4 per bushel, ending the week at 6.31-3/4. Soybean futures closed between 12.27-1/2 and 12.33 per bushel, ending the week at 12.29. Soybean meal futures closed between 320.00 and 327.50 per short ton, ending the week at 320.00. Soybean oil futures closed between 6.5216 and 6.5258 per pound, ending the week at 6.30. Wheat futures closed between 6.30 and 6.68-1/2 per bushel, ending the week at 6.30.







#### **Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel**





# Soybean Meal - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / US Ton


















#### **Barrel Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound**












#### **Live Cattle - Average Weekly Price USDA - 6 State Average**






























#### **Heating Oil - Average Weekly Spot Price - NY Harbour**









# **Gasoline Unleaded - Average Weekly Highway Price**







