Washington apples are expected to be smaller than usual for the duration of the season, but they will be of high quality and shippers expect steady demand.

Another very dry year has California grape producers hoping for more rain. Dry conditions look to continue, and even though January was close to average in total rainfall, seasonal totals are falling behind again.

CF Fresh introduced the Durandeau, an heirloom pear variety, to the U.S. organic produce market. The pears are grown by Agro Roca SA in Argentina. Volumes are limited, and the pears should begin arriving in the U.S. the first week of March.
