Weekly Market Highlights

- Wheat futures prices are mixed this week. Basis on winter wheat was lower and spring wheat basis posted higher.
- The winter wheat crop is much better than a year ago with 72% of the crop in Kansas jointed, with the five year average of 32%.
- The spring wheat crop is 21% planted in the 6 key growing states, compared to only 3% at this time last year. Farmers are making great planting progress and are expected to continue to do so.
- The weather has been the key element in both crops gaining progress and maintaining 3-4 weeks ahead of normal.
- USDA April World Supply and Demand Estimates did not reduce the carryout on corn, citing the massive wheat feeding and an expected early corn harvest.

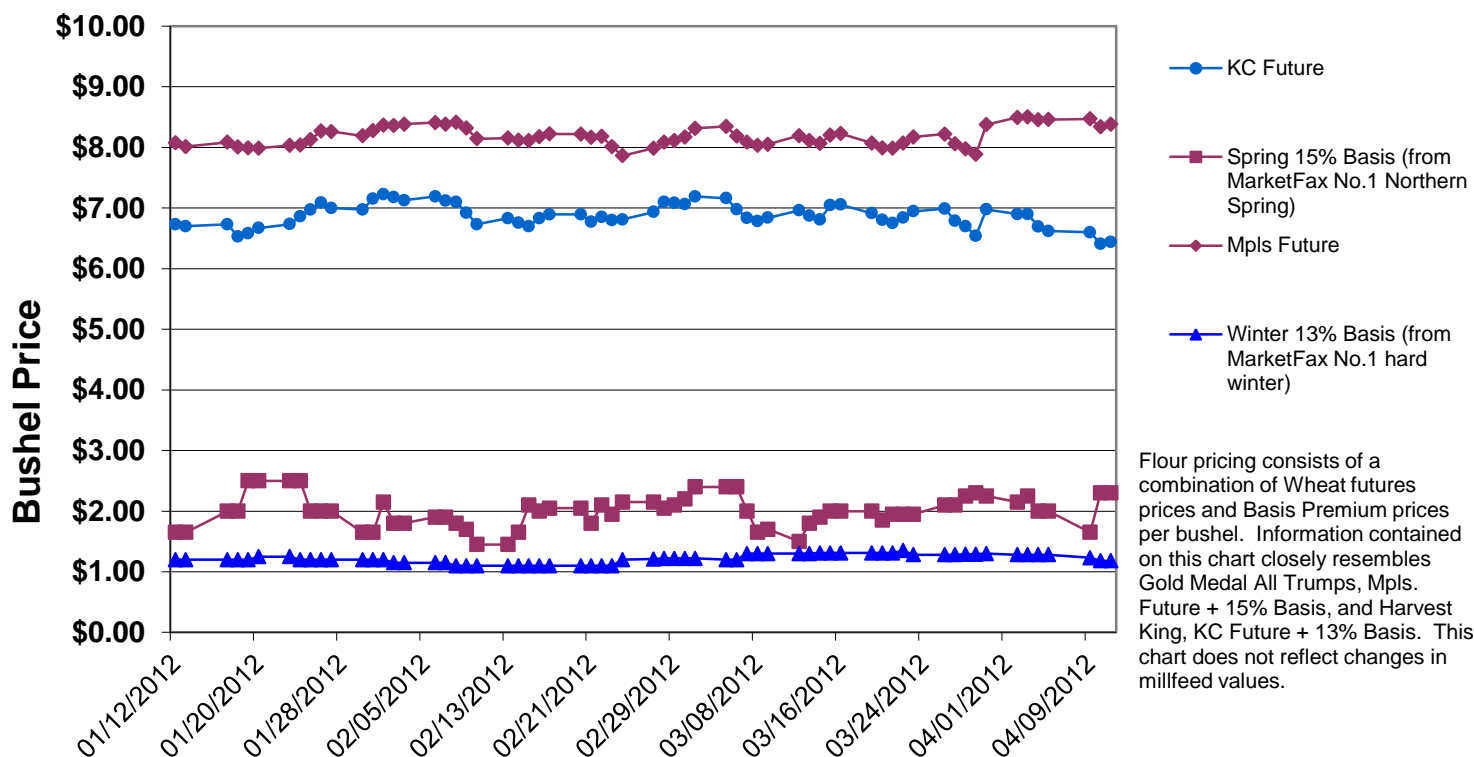
