


#### **Market Commentary**

Commentary: Last week's market action confirms still that outside influences are still in control. Economic issues in Spain and in China are now a concern... That is, a larger concern. Spain's banks are failing and looking for a bailout and China has been producing but not exporting goods at the same rate like they were. Much of their exportable goods is sitting in ships, just sitting. Let's not forget, that Europe in general continues to be a major market influence as Italy, Greece, and Portugal are still concerns that have not gone away. The U.S dollar is trending higher, commodities are trending lower, but bounced this past week, and the Dow is trending higher. If you look at it more closely, markets seem to have no real direction other than all over the place. It is very difficult to get a feel for the markets direction, so a solid hedging strategy is a must. Supply and demand (fundamental) will become the major market driver for agricultural commodities again, and the picture is still not a good one regarding supply. On the demand side, though, with the current global economic situation, perhaps fundamentals are not so far away as Europe and China are not buyers right now.


Corn futures closed between \$5.68 and \$5.98 per bushel, ending the week at \$5.98. Soybean futures closed between \$13.40 and \$14.25-1/2 per bushel, ending the week at \$14.26-1/2. Soybean meal futures closed between \$396.10 and \$429.80 per short ton, ending the week at \$429.80. Soybean oil futures closed between \$0.4831 and \$0.5039 per pound, ending the week at \$0.4946. Wheat futures closed between \$6.13-1/4 and \$6.41-3/4 per bushel, ending the week at \$6.30-1/4.







## **Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel**





























