National Egg Review

This week, all New York prices are steady. Early in the week, regional prices were lower for both the heavier and lighter weight eggs. Next week's regional asking prices are trending unchanged. The undertone is steady. Retail demand is light to moderate, instances fairly good in the Southeastern region. Food service demand is light to moderate. Offerings and supplies are moderate to instances heavy. Market activity is moderate. Central states breaking stock prices, along with checks and undergrades, are slightly lower. The undertone is mostly steady. Demand is

light with offerings moderate to heavy. Supplies are moderate to heavy. Market activity remains slow. National light type hen removal costs continue steady. Offerings are moderate to heavy on light to moderate demand. Processing schedules are full-time to over-time. Market activity is slow to moderate.

WEEKLY FRYERS AVAILABLE FOR MARKETING

Based on the preliminary chick placements, the number of fryers available for marketing during the week ending 25-Feb-12 is estimated at 149.2 million head. This compares to 149.6 million head the previous week and to 158.6 million head the same week a year ago, when the slaughter was 164.1 million head and the composite weighted average price was 75.39 cents per pound.
