NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

This week in New York, prices are steady for all egg sizes. Earlier in the week, regional prices were steady for Jumbo, higher for Extra Large and Large, lower for Medium. Next week's regional

asking prices are trending steady for both the larger and smaller sized eggs. The undertone is steady. Retail demand is moderate to good, while food service demand is reported in a full range, light to good. Offerings and supplies are light to moderate, occasionally heavy. Breaking stock prices are steady with a steady undertone. Offerings are moderate for the light demand. Supplies are moderate. Market activity is slow. National light type hen removal costs are steady. Demand is moderate for the light to moderate offerings. Processing schedules are reduced due to the Thanksgiving holiday. Market activity is slow to moderate.
