NATIONAL CARLOT MEAT TRADE REVIEW

Week Ending: Thursday, Aug 08, 2013

CARCASS PRICE EQUIVALENT INDEX VALUES

The carcass price equivalent index value of a Choice 600-900 lbs carcass was 0.61 higher at 176.43; Select 600-900 lbs carcass was 0.91 higher at 170.26 compared to last Friday.

FABRICATED BOXED BEEF CUTS AND BEEF CUTOUT VALUE

For the week, Boxed beef cutout values were higher on moderate to fairly good demand and moderate offerings. Select and Choice chuck, round and loin primals were steady to firm while the rib primal was firm to higher. The boxed beef cutout value had been decreasing since June but rebounded this week as all primals supported the cutout. The Choice rib primal had the highest gains this week with all cuts increasing in value. Fed grinds were higher on the fatter grinds while the leaner grinds were mixed; Fed 90% was lower while the Fed 93% was higher. The blended grinds went higher on the fatter grinds and lower on the leaner grinds. Forward negotiated sales were light to moderate and revealed a large consignment of Select chuck rolls priced higher when compared to the spot market. Beef trimmings were weak on light demand and light to moderate offerings.

For the week: Select and Choice rib primal 2.50 to 3.00 higher; Select and Choice chuck primal .75 to 2.25 higher; Select and Choice round primal 1.75 to 2.00 higher; Select loin primal .75 lower while Choice .75 higher . Beef trimmings were .67 lower. Fed cattle grinds were 7.50 lower to 11.75 higher; Blended grinds were 11.00 higher to 14.50 lower.

Composite of Boxed Beef Cutout Values: Choice 600/900# carcasses up 1.10 at 188.31, Select 600/900# carcasses up 1.15 at 182.05 when compared to last Friday.

COW AND BULL CARCASS, BONELESS PROCESSING BEEF, CUTTER COW CUTOUT

Lean boneless processing beef and trimmings were mostly steady to weak. Demand was moderate for moderate to heavy offerings. Trading was moderate. Weaker late summer demand and abundant supplies pressured prices. The cow and bull slaughter was lighter than anticipated. The overall cattle slaughter numbers were lower than the same period last year.

Market activity on imported beef was slow. Prices were mostly 1.00 to 2.00 lower, instances 3.00 lower compared to last week's market. Slow trading and weaker demand pressured prices.

Cutter cow cutout values were weak. Demand and offerings were light to moderate. Chuck, round, rib, and flank cuts were mixed while loin items were mostly lower. 100% lean items were mostly higher.

Lean boneless beef 92-94% steady to weak; 90% unevenly steady; 85% generally steady; 81% steady; 75% steady to weak; 65% mostly steady; Other lean percentages were not fully established. 100% lean combo items were mostly higher. Cutter cow carcass gross cutout value for Thursday, August 8, 2013 was estimated at \$160.70 per cwt, 0.72 higher compared to last Friday.

BY-PRODUCTS: VARIETY MEATS, TALLOW, PROTEINS, AND HIDES

Traders returned to the beef variety markets this week, looking for grinding meats to use in further processed retail cuts. Domestic prices moved higher on beef cheeks and head meat, pushed by increased buying interest from export markets. Heart prices slid lower as packers tried to move a growing inventory of heart meat and avoid taking significant lower money in the coming weeks. Prices for domestic tripas moved higher while Scalded edible tripe slid slightly lower for the week. Pork cheeks did not trade this week, as traders watched prices fall for 72% pork trim. Prices for domestic hearts were weaker for the week. Export demand pushed prices higher for stomachs and tongues. Prices boomed higher for uteri during mid-week, only to return to typically trading ranges by the weeks end.

Tallows and greases experienced moderate trading this week. With the exception of Chicago lard which finished higher, all tallows and greases ended lower. Weakness in soybean oil and corn oil markets added pressure to Chicago tallow and grease markets. Offerings were moderate. Moderate demand and tight supplies continued to push Chicago lard prices higher. The lower tallow prices prompted trading at the Gulf. Gulf packer tallow ended lower on light demand for moderate offerings. Central choice grease prices continued to fall. Biofuel and feed fat demand was light for moderate offerings.

Market activity on protein feed supplements was moderate this week. Lower prices on cash soybean meal continued to pressure meat and bone meal prices. Ruminant meat and bone meal prices finished lower Central and Panhandle. Demand was light for moderate offerings. Pork meat and bone meal prices fell sharply. Feed demand was light for moderate offerings. Panhandle and pork blood meal prices also ended lower on light demand for moderate offerings.

Trading on major packer hides was slow this week. Packers were dug in trying to hold prices near current levels while tanners persisted with low bids. Very little trading was reported as the week was mostly a standoff. In light tests, Colorado Branded Steers, Butt Branded Steers and Heavy Texas Steers ended lower.

Beef Variety Meats: Cheeks domestic and export 4.00 higher; Head meat domestic unevenly steady; Hearts domestic 1.00-3.00 lower, export 2.00 lower; Tripas domestic 4.00 higher; Tripe domestic 1.00 lower.

Pork Variety Meats: Pork Cheeks not tested; Hearts, slashed domestic 1.00-3.00 lower, export not tested; Stomachs, small box export 15.00 higher than most recent quote; Tongues grn bnls 14.00 higher, export no recent comparable quote; Uteri steady with last published quote.

Central choice white grease 2.25-2.50 lower; Chicago packer bleachable tallow 1.25 lower; Chicago renderer bleachable tallow 2.50 lower; Chicago edible tallow 2.00 lower; Chicago lard 1.00 higher; Gulf packer bleachable tallow 0.75-1.00 lower; Central meat and bone meal 10.00-30.00 lower; Panhandle meat and bone meal 7.50-17.00 lower; pork meat and bone meal 25.00-50.00 lower; Panhandle blood meal steady to 60.00 lower; pork blood meal 60.00-65.00 lower; Colorado Branded Steer hides 5.00 lower; Butt Branded Steer hide 4.50 lower; Heavy Texas Steer hides 2.00 lower.

The average value of hide and offal for the four days ending August 08, 2013, was estimated at 14.13 per cwt., down 0.40 from last week and up 0.87 from last year.

NORTHEAST COAST AND NORTH CENTRAL VEAL CARCASS, CUTS

Compared to last week: The special fed veal carcass market was unevenly steady on open market and higher on packer owned calves. Demand moderate for light offerings. Harvest numbers was a 12.08 percent higher compared to last week's total. Dressed weights were up .2 pounds in the Northeast, down 4.8 pounds in the North Central, with the total NE & NC being down 2.1 pounds.

Special fed veal cut prices were mixed. Chop ready and non-grilling items were lower; middle meats; fore and hind saddles and quarters were higher. Demand and offerings light to moderate.

LAMB: CARCASS & PELTS

Carcass lamb sales for the week, as of 8/8/2013, carcasses less than 45 pounds 1.24 higher; 45-65 pounds sharply higher; 65-75 pounds 0.52 lower; 75-85 pounds 1.20 higher; carcasses over 85 pounds 1.30 lower. The estimated National Lamb Carcass Cutout report was 6.36 lower compared to last week at 238.13.

Pelt prices steady on all classes. Trading very slow on light demand and offerings.
