

Market Commentary


Commentary: It is not likely, with the harvest under way, that any rain will increase the crop's size at all. In fact, it is more than likely that the rains received over the weekend will only slow the harvest. This should not really cause any issues since we are at the beginning stages of the harvest. Export reports show that soybean meal is growing in demand and that trend is likely to continue. With meal demand growing, bean crushing will increase and a building of soybean oil will occur. We may see more decrease in soybean oil futures as a result, possibly sub 40 cent oil. Before we get too excited about that, we did see the largest increase in bio-diesel production for the crop year. Corn continues to fall in futures price. The crop reports have supported that move. Volatility is starting to increase, so likely to see corn rebound.

Corn futures closed between \$4.48-3/4 and \$4.56-3/4 per bushel, ending the week at \$4.56-3/4. Soybean futures closed between \$13.07-3/4 and \$13.21-3/4 per bushel, ending the week at \$13.19-3/4. Soybean meal futures closed between \$411.10 and \$419.90 per short ton, ending the week at \$419.90. Soybean oil futures closed between \$0.4151 and \$0.4197 per pound, ending the week at \$0.4151.









Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel

























Barrel Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound




40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound




