


Market Commentary

Commentary: We are nearing the end of the month, end or the quarter, and end of the year. What does that mean? It usually means that speculators and other traders are looking to make bonuses. Volume tends to slide and volatility moves in and can affect the price in either direction. As far as the soybean complex is concerned, it is very possible that speculators will be short for soybean oil, but long for beans and meal. This is not eh worst news as the heavy demand for meal forces more oil on the market and helps run the price down for soybean oil. This also has a downward effect on other forms of vegetable oil. Right now palm oil, peanut oil, corn oil, and Canola oil are all trending downward. One oil not trending down, though is cottonseed oil. A shortage of cotton seed oil has put a run on that particular market. Some news has come out that there is some dryness in South America for the beginning of their crop. It does not seem to be too much of a concern as their planted acres have increased so much that their yield is likely to be large too. South America will likely help keep prices at bay. Much of what I have read does not make me think we will see large market runs. I think we will continue to be range bound for most agricultural markets for the long-run, minus some end-of-year activity from traders for profit purpose.









Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel

























Barrel Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound





























































Foreign Exchange Rate - Euro, EMU Members
