For the week, Boxed beef cutout values were sharply lower on very light to light demand and light offerings. After climbing to record levels last week, Boxed beef cutout values have been coming down fairly fast. On Wednesday the change from the prior day on Choice was -3.99, the 3rd highest loss on record. The record is -4.59 set 10/08/2008. The recently inflated chuck and round primals had the highest losses this week, while the loin primal remained steady. The Choice rib primal was steady while Select was firm on low volume. This week, the volume of Select and Choice cuts traded has been below 100 loads every day, this is an indication of buyer resistance to higher prices. The volume of cuts has been low in general in recent weeks and most notably on Select. So far this week there were only 115.52 loads of Select product reported; to put that into perspective, this is lower than the reported branded product of 116.65 loads. Last Friday there was only 16.61 loads of Select cuts reported, a new daily record low. Because of the reduced herd size, slaughter numbers continue to be below average leaving less product available in the pipeline. This has been the driving factor in the unseasonable up-turn in the boxed beef cutout values. Also, NAFTA and overseas exports are making up a higher percent of total production than they did a year ago further depleting domestic supplies. All Fed grinds have fallen sharply this week after reaching historic levels while blended grinds were steady. All grinds remain well above year ago levels however. Forward negotiated sales were light with a large consignment of Choice export style ribs being sold at a price higher than the spot market. Beef trimmings were lower on light to moderate demand and offerings.
