

Market Commentary


Commentary: Looking at the economic situation in South America, I am concerned. For all of the soybean and corn producing states, their have devalued their currencies. Argentina's currency exchange rate with the U.S. is 23% higher than on January 1. That is a huge change, meaning one U.S. dollar could buy 6.5 Argentine Pesos on Jan. 1 and now it can buy 8. The trend is worse for Venezuela but they devalued their Bolivar not quite a year ago, losing almost 40%. Brazil's Real is trending poorly too. Poorer exchange rates do help keep their products more affordable for China and other countries and the exports from these countries will take away U.S. business and they have. Our exports though have remained strong and China is still buying containers for beans and corn, but export prices have reduced as a result of Brazil loading exports cheaper. The unemployment rate in Europe is really bad in Italy, France, Greece, and Spain. I will keep an eye on this as any upheaval will move the markets like we had last year, etc. regarding Greece.

Traders are long on beans and meal and short on soybean oil. Bean oil has continued to trend lower as a result. Crush margins are not great though, and this trend may end. There is a stockpile of Canola as a result of a railcar issue in Canada. We are seeing basis levels very low, in fact, and all time low for Canola.










Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel































Live Cattle - Average Weekly Price USDA - 6 State Average













































