Cooler weather in Mexico, decreased production out of Peru, and Valentine's Day ads have all strengthened markets. This should continue for about a week.

## berry-strawberry

Strawberry markets have stabilized in Florida this week. Florida has good supplies; however, holiday demand has kept the market in check. Fruit should remain plentiful in Florida through the Valentine's Day push. Western fruit volumes and quality are steadily improving and heavy demand has kept this market strong this week.

Markets remain steady with good supplies and quality available. Sluggish demand should keep this market flat through this week.

#### celery

Markets are steady with good production and quality on both eastern and western celery.



#### citrus-lemons

Markets remain firm. Fruit is peaking on larger sizes as small fruit remains limited. Quality is good overall.



#### citrus-limes

Markets continue to rise on light supplies. Quality remains good.



#### citrus-oranges

Markets remain stable. Supplies on smaller fruit continue to be limited. Fruit is full color with good flavor.



# cucumber & eggplant

Increased arrivals of Honduran cucumbers have brought down markets. Quality is good. Eggplant markets are generally stable.



#### grapes

Green grapes are limited as supplies have been lighter. Imported red grapes remain stable and most fruit is arriving on the small side. Black grape volume has improved but prices remain high.



#### lettuce

Steady demand, good quality and plentiful supplies are keeping markets in line.



#### melon–honeydew & cantaloupe

Markets remain strong on cantaloupe and honeydew. Cooler weather in Central America has slowed harvest with lighter supplies. Honeydew demand exceeds supply.



#### onions

Yellow onions out of the Northwest are holding strong and expected to do so for the remainder of the season. Red onion markets are stable. White onion supplies continue to dwindle down and are expected to finish up by mid to late February.

#### peppers



Improved supplies on Florida green peppers have brought down markets on both Florida and Mexican product. Quality is excellent. Mexican red pepper markets have eased on better supplies. Volume on Mexican and offshore yellow pepper supplies have decreased, causing markets to strengthen.

Idaho potato markets remain stable. Please note: Extreme cold temperatures have caused delays in shipping.

## tomatoes

The Florida tomato market is beginning to soften with the recent stable, warm weather. While supply in the East is light, the influx of product out of the West is helping to ease prices and satisfy demand. Quality remains fair to high in both regions.
