


#### **Market Commentary**

Commentary: To start the South American harvest is underway, and in full swing. This of course puts downward pressure on the markets. However, the WASDE report is going to be released on Monday Feb 10. It is expected that the USDA will cut the carryover stocks on this report by upwards of 10 Million bushels for beans, in the U.S. Also, China is back from their holiday and we are expecting increased exports. These two factors add lift to the market. But the global view on beans is that stocks are slightly higher. So what happened last week? The stock market was volatile and some fund money flowed into commodity markets as trading volume grew. It was quiet from an export standpoint. After many weeks of decline the soybean oil market bounced a bit. Demand for bean oil is flat and there still is no subsidy from the govt. so I don't foresee any huge moves for bean oil. The winter is still very cold and this will keep corn and meal prices higher due to demand. Also the very cold winter is said to be wreaking havoc on the winter wheat crop. We will see how this shakes out. I don't see any clear direction in the markets. It is a wait-and-see scenario right now.










# Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel




























# 40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound























































