


Market Commentary

Commentary: Canola... I wrote a few weeks ago that there were issues in Canada with moving Canola. They have a railcar shortage and the winter weather is impacting their ability to transport Canola to the U.S. and to ports for export. We are seeing it trickle down but processing and packing plants for Canola are behind. Expect it to continue for a couple more weeks. We are seeing increases across the board for U.S. AG commodities as well as crude oil. The California drought is causing concern for farmers across the nation as it impacts, or will impact supply on many fronts. Lets not forget, though, there are very dry conditions in many states of our main growing area. This has farmers very concerned and in spite of good crops in South America, our prices have started to climb. So far is still looks like there will be a large switch from corn to soybeans this year. This has corn prices moving higher. It has to move higher to keep up with beans and not lose too many acres. Big money is starting to move back into commodities. I think they smell blood in the water. They can and will cause artificial demand which helps push prices higher. It is already shaping up to be an interesting growing season and planting intentions have not even been released.










Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel




























