


#### **Market Commentary**

Commentary: Last week the USDA release its stocks report but prior to that traders were anticipating what the report would say and they ran the market higher. They believed that ending stocks would be lower and they were. Also China has really been active regarding exports, so demand is very strong for beans and meal, and the supply is dwindling. In fact, if we meet China's demand, there will not be enough beans and meal available. Many cargoes will have to be cancelled. The odd thing is why did the market start to come down after the release of the USDA report? Traders simply traded ahead of the report and overbought conditions existed. Also, crude oil started to fall in price below \$100.00 per barrel, helping to bring down other commodities. Fund speculators have moved from short positions to long positions for soybean oil. While last week, futures traded lower, I don't think at this point it will last. I am still bearish over the next couple months though. If planting intentions are strong for soybeans we should see futures decline for new crop months with the possibility of inverted markets.










## Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel




























# 40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound























































