For the week, Boxed beef cutout values were lower on light demand and moderate offerings. The rib primal was steady on Choice while Select went higher, mostly driven by Select light lip ons. The chuck, round and loin primals were weak to lower with the exception of the Select loin primal that was steady. The primal with the biggest decline this session was the round primal with nearly all cuts losing value. Large price spreads were prominent is week as availability of cuts are varying from packer to packer. This is seen in the chuck and round primal as some packers are finding it advantageous to grind cuts especially round cuts; leaving more trim in the pipeline. Fed and Blended grinds were lower on all lean percentages most notably Fed ground round. Beef trimmings trended lower this session and there was 1.2 million pounds of trim reported on Wednesday, the most since Dec 11th 2013. Forward Negotiated sales were light with no major consignments.

## COW AND BULL CARCASS, BONELESS PROCESSING BEEF, CUTTER COW CUTOUT

Lean boneless processing beef and trimmings were moderately to sharply lower. Demand was light to moderate for moderate offerings. Trading activity was moderate to active. Weaker retail and food service demand and heavier than expected inventories continued to

service demand and heavier than expected inventories continued to pressure prices.

Market activity on imports was slow to moderate. Prices were mostly weak to 2.00 lower, instances 3.00 lower. Import supplies were moderate. The weaker domestic market and more available import supplies continued to pressure prices. Outfront sales were light.

The Pacific Rim countries showed limited interest with prices within striking distance of the previous week's sales.

Trading on tallows and greases was slow this week. Chicago choice white grease traded at steady prices. Chemical demand was moderate for moderate offerings. Central choice white grease finished mostly steady on moderate demand and offerings. Chicago renderer bleachable tallow traded; however there was no recent test for comparison. The Gulf markets were quiet.

Protein feed supplements experienced moderate trading this week. Ruminant meat and bone meal finished the week mixed. Central ended steady to slightly higher while the Panhandle finished steady to lower. Demand and offerings were light to moderate. Central pork meat and bone meal ended lower on light demand.
