CARCASS PRICE EQUIVALENT INDEX VALUES

The carcass price equivalent index value of a Choice 600-900 lbs carcass was 3.01 higher at 218.94; Select 600-900 lbs carcass was 2.18 higher at 207.51 compared to last Friday.

FABRICATED BOXED BEEF CUTS AND BEEF CUTOUT VALUE

For the week, Boxed beef cutout values were higher on moderate to fairly good demand and light to moderate offerings. The lower load counts on the spot market this week indicate that there wasn't a lot of trading activity but the people who were trading were willing to pay higher prices, providing optimism in the early grilling season. All primals went higher this week, however; it was the Choice loin primal that had the highest gains followed by the Select rib primal. The Choice loin cuts that drove the loin primal were grilling items, the tenderloin and 0xl bnls strip loin. While the heavy ball tip, a popular roasting item, lost value. According to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, This was the 43rd coldest March on record, and the coldest since 2002 but Temperatures across the country are warming up, and grilling season is underway. Fed grinds trended higher. Fresh 50% beef trimmings traded higher this week as packers retained more for themselves, leaving less traded on the spot market. Forward Negotiated sales were light with no major consignments.

For the week: Select and Choice rib primal 7.00 to 12.00 higher; Select and Choice chuck primal 6.00 to 7.50 higher; Select and Choice round primal 5.50 to 6.50 higher; Choice loin 8.00 to 11.50 higher; Beef trimmings were 15.84 higher; Fed cattle grinds were 9.00 to 18.00 higher.

Composite of Boxed Beef Cutout Values: Choice 600/900# carcasses up 7.45 at 2.33.80 Select 600/900# carcasses up 6.84 at 222.07 when compared to last Friday.

COW AND BULL CARCASS, BONELESS PROCESSING BEEF, CUTTER COW CUTOUT

Lean boneless processing beef was weak to lower and trimmings unevenly steady. Demand was light to moderate for moderate offerings. Trading activity was moderate. Soft retail and food service demand continued to pressure prices.

Market activity on imports was slow. Prices were unevenly steady. Import supplies were moderate. East Coast sales were weak to lower while West Coast trades were steady to firm.

Cutter cow cutout values were slightly lower. Round, loin and flank cuts were moderately to sharply higher while chuck and rib items closed mixed. 100% lean items were mixed. Weaker boneless lean prices continued to pressure cutout values.

Lean boneless beef 92-94% weak to lower; 90% weak to lower; 85% unevenly steady; 81% 2.00 lower; 75% unevenly steady; 65% generally steady; Other lean percentages were not fully established. 100% lean combo items were mixed. The cutter cow carcass gross cutout value for Thursday, April 17, 2014 was estimated at \$194.55 per cwt, 2.57 lower compared to last Friday.

BY-PRODUCTS: VARIETY MEATS, TALLOW, PROTEINS, AND HIDES

Trading on variety meats showed more life as traders returned to the market and packers were willing to take lower money. Such pricing could be seen as beef cheeks sold for substantially lower money to the start of the week only to rebound by the end of the week. For pork, heart inventories built during the Lenten season forcing packers to take lower money late in the week. Additionally traders came to the market looking for a broader assortment of variety meats compared to earlier trading sessions. While trading into China continued to be sluggish, traders from Hong Kong appeared to be buying to fill warehouses that were depleted during the Asian holidays as prices dropped. An increase of trade into Mexico could also be documented for the week.

Tallows and greases experienced slow trading this week. In a light test, Chicago packer bleachable tallow finished at steady prices. Chemical demand was light for light offerings. Central choice white ended generally steady and yellow grease steady. Feed fat and biofuel demand and offerings were light to moderate. The Gulf markets were quiet.

Market activity on protein feed supplements was slow this week. Light feed demand continued to weigh on the market. Ruminant meat and bone meal ended lower Central and steady to lower Panhandle. Pork meat and bone meal ended mostly steady in an unsettled market. Concern and anxiety over the porcine epidemic diarrhea virus (PEDV) has some feeders switching to other protein sources. Central beef blood meal ended slightly higher while Central pork blood meal finished steady. Demand for blood meal remained light. Packers struggled to move the product.

Trading on major packer hides was slow this week. Mounting tanner resistance to offered prices was a burden to the market. A crack down on environmental restrictions to Chinese tanners in the Hebei province left several buyers on the sidelines. The tone of the market was a little softer. Colorado Branded Steers and Branded Steers finished lower while Butt Branded Steers ended steady to lower.

Beef Variety Meats: Beef cheeks domestic steady, export steady; Head meat 2.50 lower; Lips no comparison; Tripe scalded edible export no comparison. Pork Variety Meats: Cheeks not tested; Hearts domestic 15.00 lower compared to last quote, export not tested; Snouts with mask steady with last quote; Green boneless tongues export 22.00 lower compare to last quote.

Central choice white grease generally steady; Central yellow grease steady; Chicago packer bleachable tallow; Central meat and bone meal 20.00-45.00 lower; Panhandle meat and bone meal steady to 20.00 lower; Central pork meat and bone meal mostly steady; Central blood meal 25.00 higher; Central pork blood meal steady; Colorado Branded Steer hides 1.0-2.00 lower; Butt Branded Steer hides steady to 2.00 lower; Branded Steer hides 0.50-1.50 lower.

The average value of hide and offal for the four days ending April 17, 2014, was estimated at 15.92 per cwt., down 0.13 from last week and up 1.56 from last year.

NORTHEAST COAST AND NORTH CENTRAL VEAL CARCASS, CUTS

Compared to last week: The special fed veal carcass market was unevenly steady on open market and packer owned calves with moderate demand and light to moderate offerings. Harvest numbers were 6.1 percent higher compared to last week's total. Dressed weights were up 0 pounds in the Northeast, up 7.9 pounds in the North Central, with the total NE & NC being up 3.6 pounds.

Compared to last week: Special fed veal cut prices were generally steady, however firmness was seen in foresaddles, forequarters and regular loins. eakness was seen in Osso Bucco items as well. Veal ad features increasedthis week. Loin chops and leg cutlets were theleading featured vealitems at lower prices. However, an increase in the number of storesoffering breast was noted at a firmer price.

LAMB: CARCASS & PELTS

Carcass lamb sales for the week were mixed, as of 4/24/2014: 45# and down weight carcasses 120.43 lower; 45-55# carcasses 1.15 lower; 55-65# carcasses were 0.31 higher; 65-85# carcasses 1.37 to 1.93 lower; over 85# carcasses 0.08 higher. The estimated National Lamb Carcass Cutout Report was 4.72 higher compared to last week at 340.03.

Pelt activity this week compared to last report: Pelt prices were steady on shorn pelts and 0.50 lower on the unshorns. As the Easter lamb market comes to a close this week, demand is slow for pelts even as market conditions in trading areas seems to have stabilized somewhat.
