


Market Commentary

Commentary: Last week we saw some relief for soybean oil as traders were profit takers. Beans traded down later in the week and soybean oil followed that trend, but did not end the week in positive territory. The bean market is struggling to achieve big gains currently, as there is talk of more cargoes coming to the U.S. from Brazil. Even though beans were positive and behind where I thought they would be, it is very clear looking at the charts and the table above that the soybean complex is very tight. We are now very positive over last year for beans and meal. The supply for oil is really what is keeping it down vs. last year, but that could change direction. While the soybean oil market did fall a little last week, cash values are higher than futures. The WASDE report is going to be released this week. There is going to be an approximate shift of 5 million acres over to soybeans this year. When this gets confirmed, we should see some softening of futures and cash values. New crop trading will start to lead the trading fight. Corn, wheat, etc. will be along for the ride.









Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel

























Live Cattle - Average Weekly Price USDA - 6 State Average















































