Whole broiler/fryer prices are trending firm in the West, firm to higher elsewhere. Offerings are light and held with confidence. Retail and food service demand is moderate to good entering the weekend. Floor stocks are short of need to moderate. Market activity is moderate to active. In the parts structure, movement is moderate to good for late week business. Prices are trending steady to higher for breast cuts; steady to firm for dark meat items and wings. Offerings of breast cuts are balanced to tight with premiums noted; wings are light and dark meat items are light to moderate for current needs. Market activity for parts is moderate to active. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.
