## **NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE**

Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to fully steady in the East, steady to firm in the West and Midwest. Offerings of all sizes are light to moderate to satisfy current trade needs. Retail and food service demand is light to moderate entering the weekend. Floor stocks are balanced with many buyers hand to mouth. Market activity is slow to mostly moderate. In the parts structure, movement increased slightly and was noted as light to moderate overall. Prices are steady to weak for breast cuts and dark meat items. Prices for wings are trending steady to higher. Offerings of wings are closely cleared; leg and leg quarters are available and other items are moderate to heavy with thigh meat noted in the longest position. Market activity for parts is slow. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

Weekly broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for the week ending 16-Aug-14 is estimated to be 157,743,000 head down 0.21 percent from a week ago, and down 0.28 percent from a year ago. (Last week 158,069,000, last year 158,185,000) Actual data incorporated when available.

#### **NATIONAL FOWL MARKET**

LIVE SPENT HEAVY FOWL Prices are trending steady. Supplies are moderate to heavy for the mostly moderate demand. Processing schedules increased slightly. Finished product supplies are adequate. Market activity is moderate with retail feature activity light with best interest being in the Northeast region.

Final Prices at Farm Buyer Loading: Price Range Wtd Avg Prices in cents per pound. 11.0-22.5 14.23 (Southeast Region broiler breeder hens generally for processing, 7 lbs. and up; under 7 lbs. subject to discount.) Southeast Region = AL, FL, GA, KY, MS, NC, SC, TN, AND VA.

LIVE SPENT LIGHT FOWL Prices are continuing to trend steady for the light demand. Offerings of light type hens are fully sufficient for current needs. Processing schedules increased slightly. Movement of finished product sales are moderate. Market activity is slow to moderate. The majority price for removal costs remains unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Retail feature activity is light with the majority of interest being in the Southeast.
