NATIONAL BROILER MARKET-AT-A-GLANCE

Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to weak in the West, steady elsewhere. Offerings of all sizes are light to moderate to satisfy current trade needs. Retail and food service demand is light to moderate with traditional items moving best. Floor stocks are mixed. Market activity is slow to moderate. In the parts structure, movement is light and generally unaggressive entering the weekend. Part prices are generally steady. Offerings of tenders and wings are light to moderate, breast cuts and most dark meat items are sufficient for current needs. Market activity for parts is seasonally slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate at mixed but mostly desirable weights.

<u>NORTHEAST BROILER PARTS</u> Prices are at least steady for tenders and wings; steady for the balance of items. Trucklot buying activity was light and generally unaggressive as dealers attempted to maintain balanced floor stocks entering the weekend. Offerings of tenders and wings are light to moderate; breast cuts and most dark meat items are sufficient for immediate needs. Movement is seasonally slow.

Broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for 28-Nov-14 and 29-Nov-14 is estimated to be 28,783,000 head down 14.61 percent from a week ago and up 4.9 percent from a year ago. (Last week 33,709,000, last year 27,445,000)

Weekly broiler-fryer slaughter under federal inspection for the week ending 29-Nov-14 is estimated to be 125,139,000 head down 19.97 percent from a week ago, and up 1.74 percent from a year ago. (Last week 156,373,000, last year 122,995,000) Actual data incorporated when available.

NATIONAL FOWL MARKET LIVE SPENT HEAVY FOWL

Prices are trending steady to firm. Supplies are sufficient for the moderate to good demand. Processing schedules are mostly normal. Finished product supplies are adequate for current needs. Market activity is seasonally moderate to active with retail feature activity noted as good with the majority of interest being in the Southeast and South Central regions.

LIVE SPENT LIGHT FOWL

Prices are trending at least steady for the moderate to good demand. Offerings of light type hens are light to moderate for current needs. Processing schedules are reduced slightly. Movement of finished product is moderate. Market activity is moderate to active. The majority price for removal costs continued unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Retail features are moderate to good with best interest being in the Southeast.
