

Market Commentary

Commentary: Soybean oil had a bit of a bounce this past week as the market was, and still is a bit oversold. It is unlikely that soybean oil will run up too high currently as crude oil is still below \$45 per barrel and soybeans are still trading downward. Also we are still wondering about what the biodiesel mandates will be. If the mandates are higher than expected we can expect bean oil futures to run much higher as this will impact the already tight supply of soybean oil. I still find it hard to believe soybean oil is so tight, but it seems to be true as the oil percentage is lower than expected and crush is lower than expected and exports are starting to tail off as South America becomes the exporter of choice. The U.S. Dollar lost a little steam last week and was lower against the Euro. This makes U.S. exports more favorable.


Two U.S. processing plants for Canola have gone up for sale which is seen as bullish, so expect some higher basis values for Canola. The margins are just not there right now for Canola.

The spread between palm oil and soybean oil is at its highest point in 120 days and palm futures are at their 5-year low. Cheaper palm oil will cause some additional imports into the U.S. Europe will likely be buying palm for their biodiesel and move some volume away from Canola and soybean oil.









Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel




























40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound
