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BROILER MARKET NEWS REPORT

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National Broiler Market-At-A-Glance

Whole broiler/fryer prices are steady to firm, mostly firm. Offerings are very light to light in the West, light to moderate elsewhere with some premiums being commanded. Retail and food service demand entering the weekend is in a full range, but mostly moderate. Floor stocks are very light to in balance. Market activity is moderate to active. In the parts structure, movement improved slightly to cover weekend business, but otherwise moderate. Prices were weak to lower for wings, steady to weak for bone-in dark meat items, and steady to firm for tenders. Supplies of wings and bone-in dark meat cuts are moderate to heavy and slow to clear, and tenders are very light to moderate. All other parts are sufficient. Market activity for parts is slow to moderate. In production areas, live supplies are moderate for mostly desirable weights.



National Mechanically Separated Chicken

(f.o.b. Shipper Dock or equivalent; negotiated prices in trucklot and less-thantrucklot volumes reported in thousand pound quantities, cents/pound; delivery within 2- weeks.)

Prices of MSC are trending steady to firm on all fat contents. Domestic and export demand is mostly moderate to good. Supplies are light to moderate. Schedules are normal. The spot marketplace is in good shape coming off the holiday last week with good demand and movement on finished goods, MSC, and frames. Buyers are also starting to build inventories of finished goods and make preparations for the upcoming peak season. Industry continues to monitor the marketplace as fresh MSC and frames settle back to more normal seasonal trends after weeks of volatility related to confirmations of highly pathogenic avian influenza; however frozen MSC continues to feel the pressures of the outbreaks. Market activity is in a full range of slow to active, mostly moderate to active. Supplies of raw materials are light to moderate. Frame prices are mostly steady with trading levels between 12.0-15.0 cents FOB, mostly 12.5-14.0 cents FOB.
