

Market Commentary

Commentary: Last week we saw a 10 month high for soybean oil and a low that was much higher than the average for the previous week. So, two weeks of higher markets which are caused, as reported last week, by tight soybean oil supplies and some added demand from biodiesel. Bird flu seems to be having some demand effect on soybean meal so the Oil/Meal ration has turned in favor of soybean oil. Rarely is this good when crushers are processing for oil over meal. We end up with inverted markets which is starting to materialize. Also we are seeing very strong speculative volume back in agricultural futures, and there is always some artificial demand when this happens. So the specs are selling meal and buying oil. There is also strong coverage from specs for beans and corn. So even though corn supplies are good and planting is going well and count of acres is good, we are still seeing increased futures prices. Biofuel mandates are affecting corn too.


There was some frost in Canada affecting Canola and some in the U.S. which might effect wheat. I have had no news about the wheat yet, but Canola seed prices have jumped as a result, so sooner or later this will cause some price increase. Close to 1 million acres were affected by the frost and need to be reseeded.

Added this week to the exchange rates is the Australian Dollar. It was added due to the ever increasing impact of Australian beef imports into the U.S. There is also a new chart added for this currency.









Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel




























40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound
