

Market Commentary


Commentary: We have certainly come down a bit since last week moving back toward 33 cents for soybean oil. Volatility is certainly measuring higher, but slowing. Speculators still have some very strong volume for soybean oil, much of it selling and profit taking. Soybean oil is not alone. There is a lot of volatility in corn, beans, meal, and even wheat. Soybeans are being crushed at a record pace and meal is the main reason. Domestic demand is strong and crushing margins are good right now. Oil share is back to 34% from 36% so there may be a basis opportunity for soybean oil. Due to wet weather soybean planting is a little behind, but I would not be concerned about it. Looking at what the traders did last week, they are not concerned either. On the Canola front margins have continued to erode and crushers are not using all of their capacity and are reducing it every week which increases the basis. Put in English, cash prices are moving higher for Canola. Farmers are working hard to replant where frost killed the Canola... over 1 million acres. This is also adding to higher cash values.











Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel




























40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound
