

#### **Market Commentary**


Commentary: The USDA reports that 100% of corn has emerged. This is good news, but due to wet weather, we have gone from ahead of schedule for soybean planting to running behind with a possible reduction of acres. At this point anything that goes in the ground is considered "Late planted," and is far more likely subject to frost, etc. Some of the issues with corn is that even thought corn is planted, the wet weather is causing issues with nitrogen depletion and possibly rot. So, even though 100% of corn has emerged some of the crop is/could be in danger. Certainly there will be corn and beans being harvested in the Fall, but this information causes traders to add premium since a reduction of yield is possible. Wheat, corn, beans, meal, oil, are all being affected by the USDA information, so as you can see the table above shows all running higher last week. Soybean stocks also may have been overstated by the USDA which should be revealed on the June 30th report. This is also adding premium to the soybean complex. We will see.











# **Soybeans - CBOT Weekly Average Price - Dollars / Bushel**




























# 40 LB Block Cheddar - CME Average Weekly Price / Pound
