TROPICAL STORM ERIKA

Puerto Rico:

As of the latest tropical storm update we are under warning for Puerto Rico, tropical storm conditions are expected within the next 24 hrs. Modules show winds are sustained at 45mph. Effective today as the storm is projected, we will not expect our night staff to drive in for tomorrow night and will not be running the trucks for Friday Morning for deliveries. All that is needed should be ordered tonight until Saturday. Flash flooding and landslides are expected for certain areas. If weather changes and do not pose a threat to the safety of our team, we will advise immediately. If anyone is aware of road outages or is affected by the storm please let us know so we can help work on an alternate routes and assistance. Seastar barges have also reported a possible delay so we will try to keep everyone posted.

Florida:

The storm is projected to be hurricane strength and reach FP South Florida on Monday. Based on the current path, FP South Florida will not make deliveries on Monday. Please bulk up Saturday to carry you through to Tuesday. The storm is expected to be downgraded to a tropical storm again by time it reaches the Central Florida area on Monday. Deliveries are questionable so we are asking that customers bulk up Saturday to carry to Tuesday as well. FP West Coast Florida may have some areas impacted but should be able to deliver most routes on Monday. The storm may or may not reach hurricane strength on Monday.
