Harvest of Perlette variety expected to begin by April 30. The Hermosillo Grape Growers Association estimates the 2016 crop at 14.2 million 18-pound cartons, down from 17.2 million in 2015. Early white seedless varieties have been estimated at 871,000 18-pound cartons, up 15 percent from 758,750 in 2015. The 2016 Flame Seedless crop is estimated at 7.6 million cartons, down 12 percent from 8.7 million in 2015. The Sugraone crop is estimated at 3.1 million cartons, down 26 percent from 4.2 million in 2015. Quality is expected to be generally good.
